SYRIA RESPONSE: When Syria's civil war besieged the Christian town of Maaloula, its residents fled to Damascus seeking refuge and assistance at the Church of the Holy Cross. To date, more than 500 displaced Syrian families have been registered to receive humanitarian assistance through

IOCC and church partner, Greek Orthodox Patriarchate of Antioch and All the East (GOPA), and IOCC continues to assess the needs of additional families arriving in search of refuge.



FRESH HOPE FOR FAMILIES IN GREECE: IOCC's new fresh food initiative gives Greece's most vulnerable families the opportunity to purchase locally sourced fruits, vegetables and milk at supermarkets using a fresh food card. The program is also helping to sustain 500 Greek farming families who are providing the fresh foods being offered to the program participants.

The program has received support from The Jaharis Family Foundation, Inc. which announced a challenge grant to support IOCC's efforts to respond to hunger relief and other aid to Greece.
