“God intervened, and my child is very well,” said Aregu, a 25-year-old Ethiopian mother. “I am very happy.”

Aregu was talking about her daughter Mekiya, age 3, who was diagnosed with acute malnutrition through an IOCC program in rural Ethiopia. Aregu works hard but has struggled to provide for her two children amid civil conflict, recurrent drought, and an overwhelming desert locust infestation.
